This lecture takes the participants on a world tour of International transboundary river basins covering rain-dominated environments (in South America), inland river basins (Okavango and Aral Sea), lakes systems (the Great Lakes), aquifer systems (Ogallala), arid planes (Euphrates-Tigris), and rain and glacial fed systems (Mekong, Sava). The lecture not only covers diverse geographies, but diverse economies as well as regional geopolitics adding complexity to the situation where sharing is a challenge, and links these case studies to the Indus River Basin.
